The program is also unique in that it is one of the first in the U.S. to offer bilingual support services for weight loss patients.



### **UofL Health – UofL Hospital**

UofL Hospital is a 404-bed hospital that has the only Level 1 Trauma Center and adult burn unit in the region. It was the first in Kentucky to be named a Joint Commission-certified Comprehensive Stroke Center.
